The various Continental 4cyl engines have a wide range of placarded ignition timing settings and Electroair will need that information when shipping a kit for a Continental. The timing information for the engine can be found on the engine placard. Electroair's Partner Distributors will ask you for this information. On-going ignition projects at Electroair

Six Cylinder Engines: Electroair is pleased to announce that development of a six cylinder electronic ignition system for certified aircraft is now well underway. Electroair is working on systems for both Continental and Lycoming six cylinder engines. Electroair expects to begin receiving design approvals within the next 4-6 months. The projected list price for the six cylinder systems is \$5,500. These systems will be available through the Electroair Partner Distribution network. The initial approved systems will be for normally aspirated engines.

Piper Light Twins: Electroair is reporting that flight testing of the Piper Light Twins is nearly complete and expects to finalize the documentation required for adding the Piper Light Twins to the Approved Model List shortly. This addition to the AML will include the Seminole, Twin Comanche, and Apache. Electroair is hoping to receive these approvals by the end of the year.
